ALWAYS BEFORE MAILING A PACKAGE DO THE FOLLOWING

1. Check With the missionary as to what you have to send and ask for specific mailing instructions. (e-mail address is available from your district NMI president)
 2. SIZE/WEIGHT/COSTS: Check with your local post office for updated instructions or go to www.USPS.com/business/international
 2. **MARK PACKAGE:** “Used material—No Cash Value—Not for Resale”
 3. VALUE: None (If post office insists on a value, put “50” cents.)
 4. DUTY: Send \$2.00 per package to Global Treasury Services for all countries.
 5. FORMS: Place a Parcel Form (X-13) in each package mailed. Download from www.nazarenemissionsinternational.org/10117/story.aspx
 6. INFORM: Write the missionary or contact person whenever a box is mailed, stating when the box was postmarked and what was sent.
 7. **E-MAIL:** **Provide an e-mail address for acknowledgment of package.**
